GUIDE FOR MS QUARTZ



Protection

Use Trivets or Hot Pads

While MS Quartz is more heat resistant than other natural stone surfaces, it can be affected by sudden and rapid temperature changes. We recommend using trivets/ hot pads to be placed under hot pots and pans to prevent excessive localised heat damaging the MS Quartz surface due to thermal shock.

Use Chopping Board

While MS Quartz is scratch resistant, cutting or chopping food directly on the surface is not recommended.

Avoid Exposure to High Impact

Avoid exposure to high impact, especially on the edges. Excessive weight should not be placed on the countertop; eg. Tradesperson should not be standing on countertop to perform painting or electrical work.

Cleaning

Regualr Cleaning

MS Quartz surfaces are highly durable and resilient. Thus, a basic care and routine is sufficient to keep your MS Quartz clean and beautiful for years to come. Simply wipe with a soft clean cloth and a pH neutral household liquid detergent. Any spills should be cleaned or wiped off immediately when noticed.


Cleaning of Stubborn Stains or Dried Spills

First, apply a non-abrasive/ ph neutral house hold cleaner and rinse to remove residue. To remove adhered material, gently scrap away the excess with a plastic putty knife. Then, clean the surface with a clean, damp cloth to remove any residual dirt.

General Maintenance Products

- It is recommended to use cleaning products that are PH neutral. Mix according to package directions.
- Do not use cleaners which contains bleach, chlorinated compounds or acetone
- Do not use abrasive or harsh scrub pads

Should your surface be exposed to any damaging products, rinse immediately with clean water to neutralize the effect.
